

## ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT (EIS) PROCESS

1. Prepare and lodge draft EIS.
2. Final Draft EIS preparation, including Queensland State Government review of the draft EIS.
3. Draft EIS public notification.

*Note - Queensland State Government advice agencies will also make a submission at this point.*

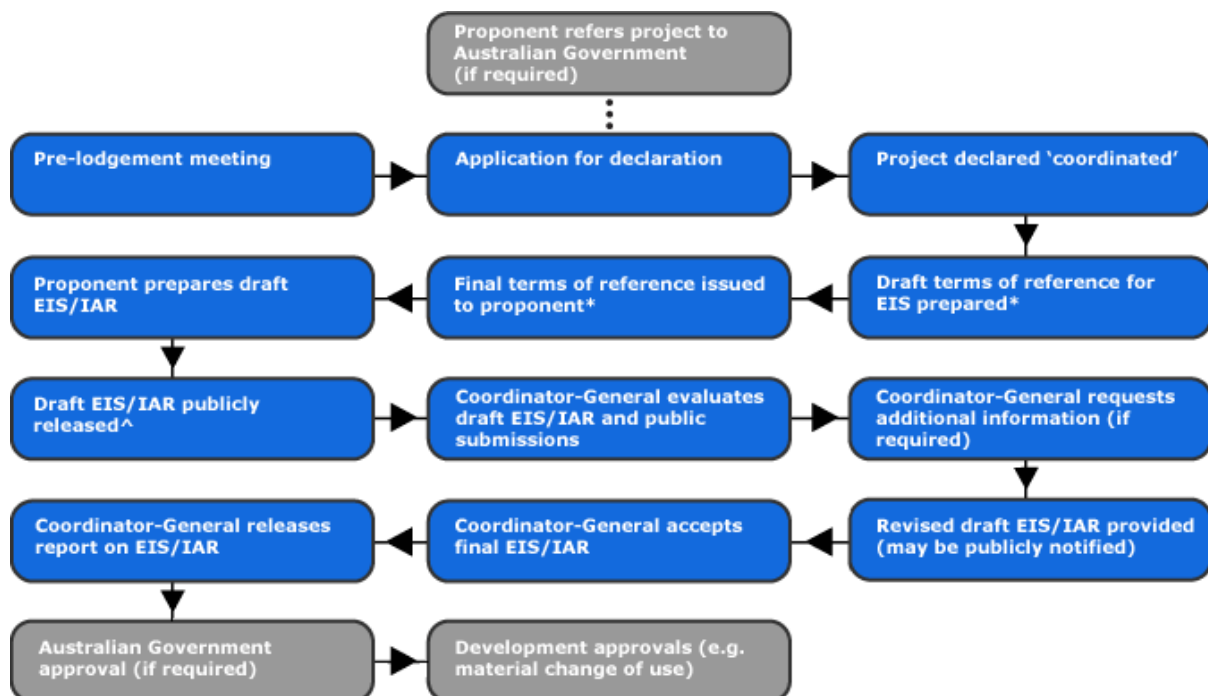
4. Revised draft EIS (resolves matters raised during public notification).

*Note - Advice agencies will also make a submission at this point, whether or not the revised draft EIS is publicly notified.*

*Note - This is a discretionary step.*

5. Queensland State Government decision.
6. Australian Government decision.
7. A Variation Request (Development Application) is lodged, seeking preliminary approval for the development, which seeks to vary the effect of the Planning Scheme.
